On February 3rd, our day care director left with a 12 hour notice. The story has not ended yet. On the day after the director left the center had the NY State Office of Children and Family Services received two complaints, and the inspector came to our day care center. As a result, our church needs to fix many things based on the 11 page request list.

Eight years ago I wanted to leave the previous church in CT because I felt my ministry was getting routine. I used to play golf twice a week, hitting mid-80s. Obviously, as I wished, my ministry at our church has never been routine, especially during the past week. Now, I miss the routine ministry!

However, I was able to experience God as I watched many of you dedicating yourselves to our church. I heard God's voice and saw God's face in such devotion. Our Lay Leader, Christine Hoff, has worked for more than 10 hours a day Monday through Friday. Our Church Council Chair, Lois Fallen, said, "I will not take this job even if I get paid \$1,000 a day, but I am doing this for free for our church."

Louise Bernard and Edward Shirley worked day and night to fix things to meet the requests of the State inspector. Donna Lechner came to the church office on her day-off. Cathy Bernard, Millie Kresse, Diane Timmoney, Tom Wilson, and much more volunteers have worked for our day care center during the past week.

As mentioned before, it was the toughest week in my ministry. I was so tired that I fell asleep, sitting on the couch. Yet this week gave me the opportunity to experience God. As I watched many of you devoting yourselves to our church, I was sure that you and I can do great things for God and God's church and our neighbors.

May the Lord, who has kept our church during the past 203 years, continue to guide us, giving us strength for the spiritual journey! The purpose of the journey is to glorify God by loving, understanding, serving, respecting, and helping each other. Amen.
