She had to walk about 3 miles to go to church, but she was thankful that she could worship God during the War, and she was always looking forward to Sunday. She said to me, "Nowadays, Christians rarely have a chance to risk their lives for their beliefs. Nevertheless, sincere Christian faith is still needed in our complicated modern society."

She was an ordinary person, but she was special and blessed by God because she tried to follow Jesus Christ. She remains as a saint for me. I know that you also have your own saints. Let us remember and honor our own saints who have taught us to live our lives in glory to God, in Jesus' most holy name. Our saints now rejoice and leap for joy because their reward is great in heaven.
