## THE JOURNEY OF FAITH

During this season of Lent, we are journeying with Jesus to the cross. It's not as somber as it sounds because we are looking forward to Easter Sunday morning. *"Hallelujah, Jesus is alive. Death has lost its victory and the grave has been denied. Jesus lives forever."* 

Ours is a journey of faith; that's what God requires of us. "But without faith it is impossible to walk with God and please God, for whoever comes near to God must necessarily believe that God exists and that God rewards those who earnestly and diligently seek God." (Hebrews 11:6)

We are a people of faith. We have confidence and belief in God whom we cannot see; yet, we know that God exists. Our faith gives us the ability to know God. Like the prophets and people of the Old Testament, we know God during our most difficult times.

In Genesis 16 is the story of Hagar, Abraham and Sarah. In antiquity, a barren wife could give her maid to her husband to produce a child – a surrogate wife. It has been 10 years since God promised Abraham and Sarah an offspring. So, they decided to take matters into their own hands. Sarah gave Hagar, her maid, to her husband, Abraham, as a surrogate wife. "So, Abram had sexual relations with Hagar, and she became pregnant."

When Hagar knew that she was pregnant, she began to treat her mistress with contempt. Sarah dealt with Hagar so harshly that she finally ran away. In the midst of her misery, Hagar, alone, doesn't know what to do or where to go. God showed up. Even when we make a mess of our situations, God still has our backs. The angel spoke to Hagar, calling her by her title, "Sarah's servant." The angel admonished her to return to her mistress and submit to her. From that day, thereafter, Hagar knew God by another name: "El Roi, the God who sees" me in my difficulties.

Is your faith alive as we journey through this Lenten season? Do you believe that God sees you in your struggles and is there to provide for your every need? How do you call God, Jehovah Jireh—the God who provides or Jehovah Rapha—the God who heals? What is your name for God? Let's bring our faith alive and believe that the God who exists is also the God who sees us and comes to our rescue.
