We Spring into the New Season!

A wonderful time of the year to welcome the new season as we look forward to Phase 2 of the Restoration Project. Board of Trustees President David Timmoney and Vice President Greg Goodrich have been a blessing with their knowledge of the building and the work that needs to be done. They have been working to see the restoration of the church and parsonage come to completion.

We met with Joel Snodgrass, the architect who will be working closely with the contractors to restore our sanctuary. Joel is the principal of Steward Preservation Services LLC and he specializes in preservation and restoration of sacred, sites such as our 210-year historic building. We want to concentrate on fixing problems to avert making continuous repairs in the future. We are also blessed to be working with the New York Landmarks Conservancy in restoring our beautiful sanctuary. God has shown us favor in sending us help. We can say like the psalmist, "Our help is in the name of the Lord who made heaven and earth." (Psalm 124:8)

On March 1, Long Island Head Start moved back into Bay Shore and is leasing the second floor of the Education Building. Preparing for Head Start movein was not a part of the Capital Campaign funding. The trustees applied for a loan from the New York Annual Conference and were approved. A loan in the amount of \$45,000 was awarded, 10% of which was given as a grant with a repayment amount of \$40,500. Monthly payments of \$450 are being made from the trustees account.

We are thankful and grateful for all of you; we will see this restoration project through because of your faithfulness to the ministry. We thank you and our wonderful Bay Shore neighbors for their support in helping us raise the funds. We are blessed to be a part of this thriving community of Bay Shore and Brightwaters.

During the Lenten season, we are meeting after Sunday services for a 20-minute Bible study to discuss the sermon. It is a wonderful experience, with our brothers and sisters interacting over the sermon and sharing joys and pains of our faith journeys. Don't miss the opportunity!


